Welcome back.



We are in the process of changing our school uniform supplier to a local Walsall shop that will enable you to purchase items directly with them rather than via the school. We do still have items of stock in school that you will be able to purchase up until July at the current prices, but once we've sold that stock we won't be reordering again, all purchases will then have to be made directly with Atlas Embroidery, 1 to 3 Manor Industrial Estate, Pleck Road, Walsall, WS2 9XX

We have always kept our prices low and sold them at cost price, however there will be a small price increase for items purchased from our new supplier. These prices are in line with all other uniform shops and all other local schools. By outsourcing our uniform, it will give our parents the flexibility to purchase during school holidays and at weekends. If you would like to purchase any stock that we have remaining I would urge you to do so now because when it's gone it's gone!
