



This week the children in year one enjoyed a Zoo lab workshop where they encountered a number of animals. This linked to their science topic. The session was fun informative and hands on.

Our year six pupils had a practical (hands on) science lesson dissecting a heart. The children were very knowledgeable about the function of the heart and enjoyed this interactive session. It was clear to see how much new knowledge they had learnt on their science topic this term. On Wednesday we had a visit from Loudmouth theatre company for year six. Loudmouth is an innovative theatre in education company. Our year six pupils were extremely knowledgeable and asked some challenging questions to our visitors.

On Thursday I did a learning walk around school for mathematics. Our children in year one were learning to use a ruler to measure in centimetres. Year two explored measures and links to fractions. Year three pupils were adding fractions with the same denominator. The year six children were reflecting shapes in the axes and using four quadrants. In all classes the pupils explored new vocabulary and demonstrated super understanding.

As you are aware we had a two day Ofsted inspection this week on Wednesday and Thursday. As soon as the report is released I will upload a copy to our website and let you know. Thank you for your continued support.

Finally, well done to 6BH for achieving 98.32% attendance this week. That's two weeks running now for them. Keep up the great work.
