Bentley Lane – Proposed road safety scheme

Road Safety

Walsall Council has responsibility for road safety. We review collisions involving injury on an annual basis and Bentley Lane has been identified as a poor performing road when compared to other similar roads in the Borough.

Collision History

There have been a total of 11 collisions in the last 5 years, 5 involving serious injury.

Draft Plans

Draft road safety proposals have been drawn up to help reduce the risk of collisions and prior to the scheme being finalised, we would like to hear your views on the draft plans.

The proposals include full width speed humps, pedestrian islands at Lane Avenue and road narrowings which aim to slow vehicle speeds.
