

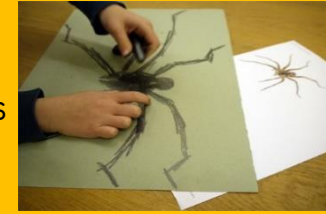

Key skills

- Practice and develop sketchbook use, incorporating the following activities: drawing to discover, drawing to show you have seen, drawing to experiment, collecting, sticking, writing notes...
- Enjoy looking at artwork made by artists and finding elements which inspire.
- Generate ideas through exploration of materials, building an understanding of what each material can do, how it can be constructed.
- Explore a variety of drawing starting points (stimuli), including close looking via observation from primary & secondary source material, drawing using imagination.
- Revisit colour mixing and understand relationships of primary and secondary colours.
- Use new colour mixing knowledge and transfer it to other media, e.g. soft pastel or plasticine
- Explore how 2d can become 3d through "design through making"

New Knowledge

Use imagination to explore portraiture. Develop a sketchbook to include information about the artist Paul Klee and drawing activities to evaluate.
