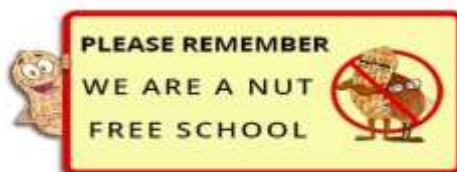
Across school it's has been mental health week. Our pupils have been creating a wellbeing plant. Look out for pictures on Twitter.

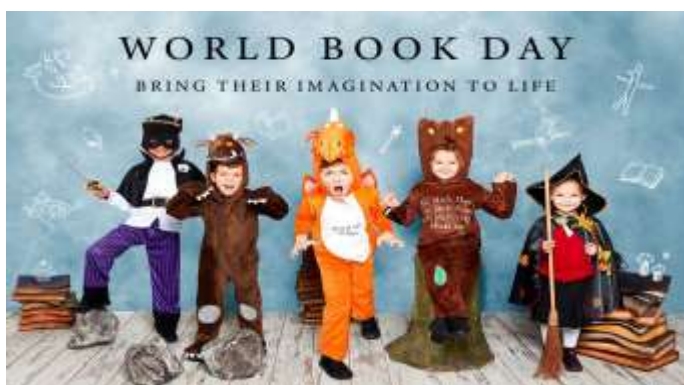
