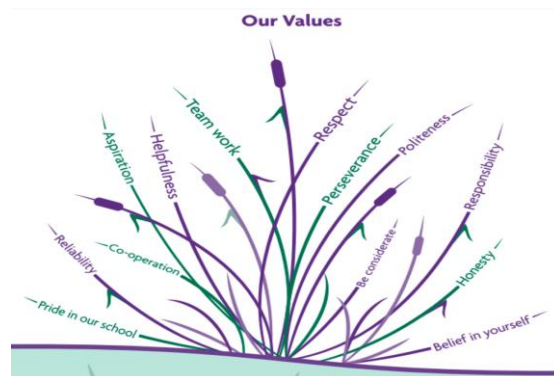
Our year five pupils enjoyed the 'hands on science' workshop on Thursday. The children were keen to take part and work together really well.
