WE'RE GOING COMPLETELY CASHLESS...

As you know we have used Parent Pay since 2020 for payment of trips, lunches, uniform etc. We continued to accept cash for tuck items, however **from Tuesday 7th November** we will **no longer be accepting cash** and all tuck payments MUST be made on Parent Pay at the start of each week if you require your child to have morning tuck.

BREAKFAST CLUB

We have had to review our breakfast club provision. From Tuesday 7th November spaces will be limited to strictly 40 per day at a cost of £1 per child per day including breakfast. To book your space please speak to Mrs Hammond in the school office. **All spaces must be paid in advance, either weekly, half term or termly via Parent Pay**. This service is primarily used for working parents dropping off at 8am. Unfortunately, we will no longer be able to accept late arrivals after 8.20am who have been using the service as an early drop off only but not staying to breakfast. Any children that have been invited to breakfast club as they are attending an academic booster session free of charge will continue as normal and won't be affected.
