MEDICINES

In order for us to administer Calpol or Cough Mixture in school all bottles must be dispensed via a pharmacy with your child's name clearly on the label.

If your child has been prescribed antibiotics **3 x per day** then ALL dosages should be administered at home there is no requirement for school to administer. E.g. they can receive a dose before school, after school and before bedtime.

ONLY if your child has been prescribed antibiotics **4 x per day** will school need to administer a lunchtime dose. We would monitor each case individually of any children having 4 doses of antibiotics per day to check whether they are fit for school.
