PARKING/DRIVING OUTSIDE SCHOOL

Walsall council Civil Enforcement officers patrol schools on a daily basis and issue PCN's (penalty Charge Notices) to vehicles parking in contravention. Civil Enforcement officers patrol all schools in the borough on a rota Basis. Reedswood have requested more regularly visits where PCN's (penalty Charge Notices) will be issued for incorrect parking.

It is a criminal offence to exceed 20mph in Bentley Drive and to park on the footpath and over residents drives and residents are advised to take photos of the vehicle and vehicle registration plate and to send it to the police or speak to 101.

Whilst it may be convenient for yourself to park on the Zigzags and yellow lines, this again is a criminal offence. They are there for the safety of the children.

The local authority is currently reviewing the request of permanent cameras being installed outside the school. Again this is for the safety of our children as child safety is paramount at Reedswood.

Reminder that Reedswood do not operate a drop off policy. ALL year groups are to be brought on the premises by an adult that is to stay with the child until they have gone into class
